RACE BIBS

To avoid gatherings and minimise queues for bib numbers, you will be able to collect your race bib, timing chip, map and cup (for use at the feed zones as well as finish zone) in Ottsjö, at the same place where the Salomon 27K started. This is also where you'll find the bag drop, where each participant will have a designated space of 1-2 sqm.

You will receive an SMS on Friday with your start number. To speed up the process, supply the staff with the sms as well as your full name when collecting your race number.

REUSABLE CUP

When collecting your race pack, all participants will receive a cup to be used at the drinks stations. A number of years ago we made a conscious decision to eliminate paper cups from the event due to environmental issues. Bring this foldable cup along the race to make sure you keep hydrated at the stations. The use of this specific cup is not obligatory; you can use any cup of your choosing.

TRAIL BEHAVIOUR

Depending on your speed, athletes may encounter other trail users during the event. If you meet someone on the trail, please abide by the following rule:

Keep right and show mutual respect for each other's line choice.

BUS TRANSFER TO THE START

ALL participants must fill in the form below informing the race organisers whether or not they need transport to the start, or from Ottsjö to the start after having made their own way to Ottsjö for the bag drop. Transfers are also available from Åre, Trillevallen, Undersåker directly to Fångåmon, where you can deposit your mid-race bags, which will then get taken to your chosen locations by race staff.

TIPS FOR BOOKING YOUR BUS TRANSFER

– I want my car at the finish of the race

Drive to Ottsjö and park at one of the designated parking spots by the boats so that you can then make your way to the bus stop by the roadside.

After finishing the race, the finish zone is approximately 50 metres from the car park.

– I want a bus transfer directly to the start from where I'm staying

We offer a transfer services from Åre train station, Undersåker train station and Trillevallen at your expense. For those who have booked accommodation at Vålådalens Fjällstation, Edsåsdalen or Copperhills Mountain Lodge, the transfer is included in your package; confirm with the staff at your lodgings that they will provide a suitable transfer for your start time.

POST-RACE TRANSFER / KIA FJÄLLTRANSFER

KIA Fjälltransfer refers to our concept of free transfers in KIA's range of electric cars to all locations in the vicinity, as well as a route to Åre. No set departure times; transfers will depart when full for the respective destinations.

*Mindful of the fact that numbers need to be kept at a minimum, it is extra important at this edition of the race that participants leave the finish zone and make their way to the car park or the KIA Fjälltransfer zone as soon as possible. Post-race food will be distributed after crossing the line for participants to eat after they have left the zone — Be aware that the traditional post-race festivities are not possible due to current circumstances. **Supporters and spectators are not permitted.***

Post-race kit

When you collect your race number you will receive a sticker with your race number on it to be placed on your bag of clothing to change after the race; these bags will be transported to the finish in Ottsjö.

Drop these bags at the designated spot at the start and these will be transported by the race organisers to the finish zone.

- Magnetisk kompass
- Behållare för minst en ½ liter vätska
- Visselpipa
- Vindtäta byxor

- Två nummerlappar
- Karta
- Käsa för vätskestationer



Forgotten anything? Don't panic! Hansons butik in Åre's main square has all of the obligatory equipment available for any last-minute purchases.

RULES

- All litter, including paper, bottles etc., must be carried until you reach the nearest control station or the finish line.
- We ask that all competitors take responsibility for their own wellbeing as well as those around them. As such, we expect you to take care of an injured athlete until help arrives.
- If a runner wishes to pull out of an event, it is necessary to inform the nearest control station.
- Support is not essential. External support is only permitted at the three food/drink stations, but not along the route.
- All participants must be aware of the inherent risks when competing in an off-road running event like this. Participants must possess the requisite experience to partake in such an event. Any seriously injured athletes will be escorted to safety as quickly as possible by the event's designated first-aid staff, however, the weather and terrain conditions can affect the speed with which a rescue can be carried out. As such, it is essential that athletes adhere to the obligatory kit list.

CUT-OFF TIMES

The following cut-off times apply:

Ottsjö, 54 km 14.30

Edsåsen, 80 km 19.30

You must have passed these checkpoints by this time. Participants who have not yet reached the checkpoint have to retire from the race for safety reasons. The race organisers will arrange transport to the finish line.

SHOWERS & TOILETS

No public access to shower facilities this year.

Portaloos will be available around the finish zone as well as the feed zones.

POST-RACE BANQUET – VIDEO – PHOTOS

All organised post-race festivities have been withdrawn from this year's programme.

PRIZE CEREMONY
