RACE NUMBERS

You do not need to show identification to collect your start number. Where and when to collect your number:

Thursday 30/7 15:00-17:45 **Ottsjö**, Fjällmaraton Centre

Entries can be made ONLINE all day up until 17:30.

Plan ahead when it comes to collecting your race number – try to be early in case there's a rush of late entries.

DRINKS STATION

At approximately 4 km, runners will pass a hydration station with water.

Tips for those coming by car to Ottsjö

Drive into Ottsjö and follow the directions given by Trillevallen Sportklubb, who will direct you to a parking space Your contribution of 60:- SEK includes the parking service and a transfer back to your car after the race. Please follow the instructions given by our volunteers and park in the designated spots to minimize disruption to landowners, the emergency services and residents.

RULES

- Runners must follow the waymarked route.
- All litter, including gel wrappers, bottles etc., must be carried unless you reach the nearest checkpoint or the finish line.
- If an athlete wishes to pull out of the event, you have to inform the nearest staffed checkpoint.
- Poles are not allowed.

OBLIGATORY KIT

OBLIGATORY EQUIPMENT OTTSJÖ 8K ARE

The equipment listed here is for the safety of participants and must be carried on your person throughout the entire race. Spot checks will be carried out at the finish. Any missing items will result in a time penalty of 15 minutes/item.

SHOWERS & TOILETS

There's a prime bathing spot in Ottsjö lake located around 700 metres from the finish. Toilets will be available around the start/finish zone.

PRIZE CEREMONY

20:10 All participants who complete the Ottsjö 8K route will be entered into a live prize draw.

The prize pot totals a grand 100,000 SEK and includes a vast number of prizes that will be distributed at random amongst the participants.
